MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST TRAINEE AND INTERN SUPERVISION INFORMATION

General Qualifications

Licensed mental health professionals interested in providing supervision to Marriage and Family Therapists (MFT) Trainees and Interns must meet certain minimum qualifications in order to supervise. The qualifications differ depending on the license type of the potential supervisor. Listed below are the licensed mental health professionals authorized to supervise MFT Trainees and Interns and some of the general qualifications needed to provide supervision to a MFT Trainee or Intern. For further specific information, please review sections 1833 – 1833.2 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations. This information only applies to those supervising MFT Trainees and Interns.

Marriage and Family Therapist – MFTs must possess

- a current and valid California license for at least two years prior to the commencement of supervision,
- complete a 6-hour supervision training within 60 days of commencement of supervision and every renewal period thereafter,
- and practiced psychotherapy or provided direct supervision of ASWs, Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT) Trainees
 or Interns who performed psychotherapy in two of the past five years immediately preceding the commencement of
 supervision.

Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) - LCSWs must possess

- a current and valid California license for at least two years prior to the commencement of supervision,
- complete a 6 hour supervision training within 60 days of commencement of supervision and every renewal period thereafter,
- and practiced psychotherapy or provided direct supervision of ASWs, Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT) Trainees
 or Interns who performed psychotherapy in two of the past five years immediately preceding the commencement of
 supervision.

Six Hour Supervision Training

LCSWs and MFTs supervising MFT Trainees and Interns must complete a minimum of six hours of supervision training or coursework (usually one course) prior to commencement of supervision and every renewal period thereafter.
