

Cap and Gown Rental (Regalia)

Cap and Gowns can be rented starting May 5th at the USC bookstore on the 3rd Floor.

Cap & Gown FAQ's

- Q: I am unable to come to campus. How do I order my cap and gown?
- A: Orders can be taken via www.uscbookstore.com starting February 2014 May 6, 2014 ONLY.

All online orders must be shipped. The fee for shipping/processing is \$20.00. Due to limited storage, gowns cannot be stored if ordered online. For additional questions, please call 213.740.8997

- Q: How do I get my hood?
- A: Your hood is included with your regalia order by indicating which degree you're receiving.
- Q: Can I rent or purchase my hood by itself?
- A: Yes, for additional information contact the USC Bookstore at 213.740.8997.
- Q: Who wears tams?
- A: Ph.D. and Ed.D. students may wear tams instead of mortar boards (caps) at the ceremony. Tams must be purchased; mortar boards are included with cap and gown rentals.
- Q: How do we manage our hoods and gowns before and during the ceremony?
- A: It's recommended to hang your gown to avoid wrinkling. Your hood should be carried on your left arm until you are "hooded" by your chair.
- Q: What color is my hood?
- A: Master's/Ed.D. Light Blue (make sure the USC Bookstore knows it's an education degree)
 Ph.D. Dark Blue
- Q: Who is eligible for honor cords?
- A: Undergraduate students only.
- Q: If I have graduated from another USC school, can I wear my robe from that ceremony?
- A: Yes
- Q: When is the deadline to order my robe if I want to buy it?
- A: March 17. It takes weeks to produce and ship the regalia. Visit www.uscbookstore.com for more details.
